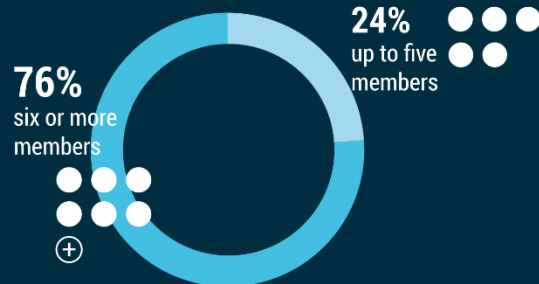

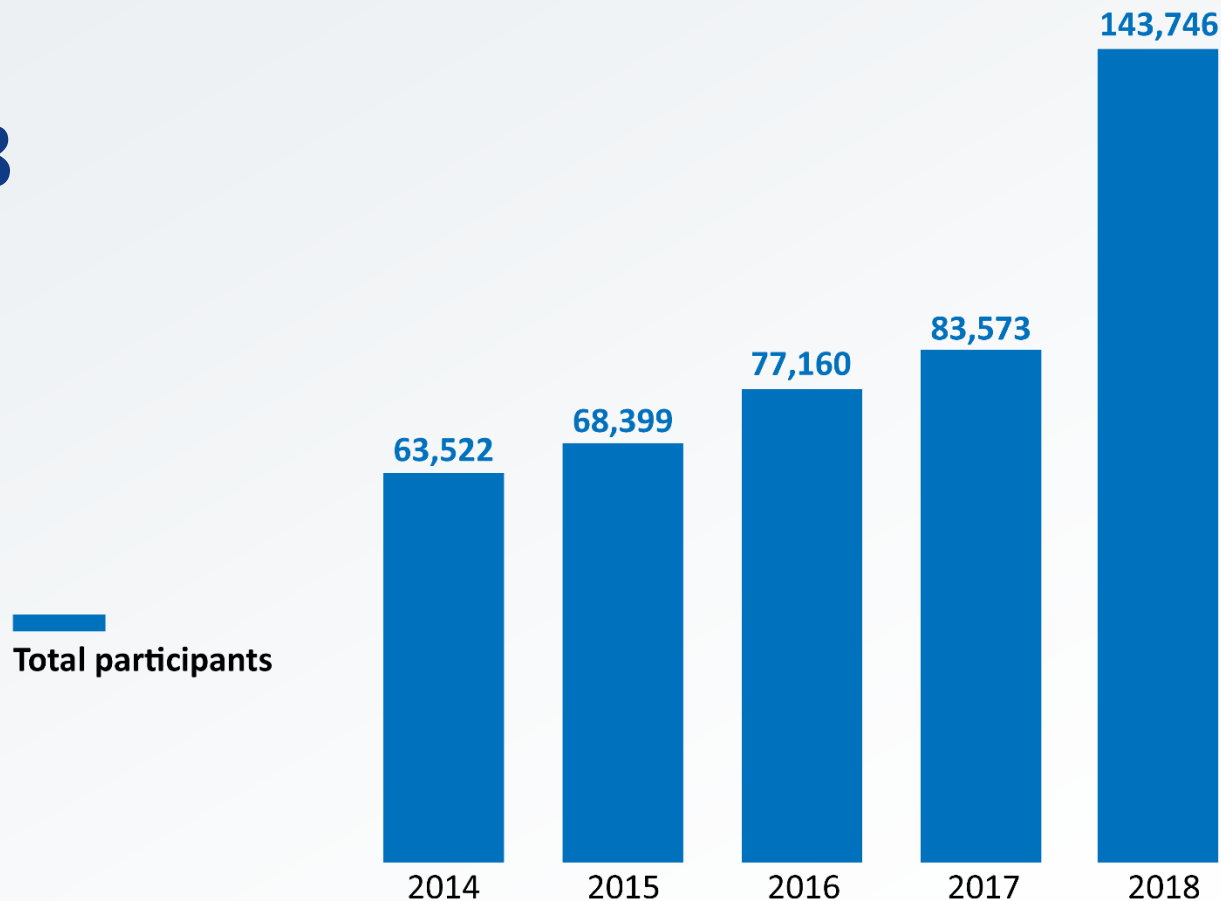


Europol can presently exchange:

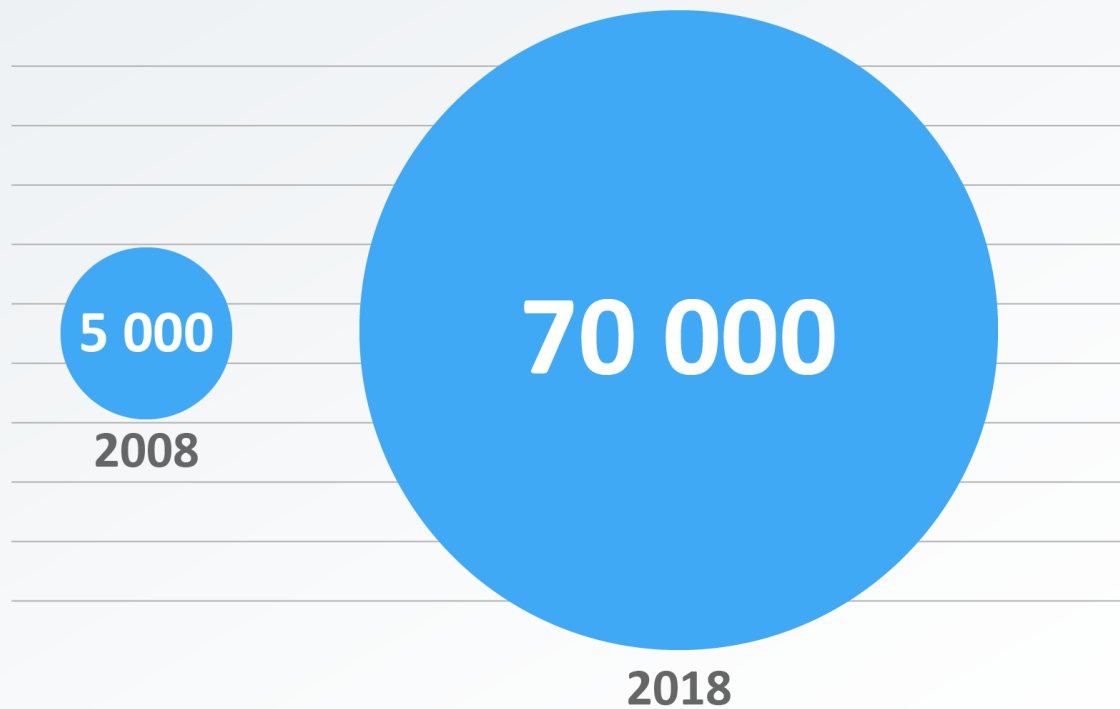

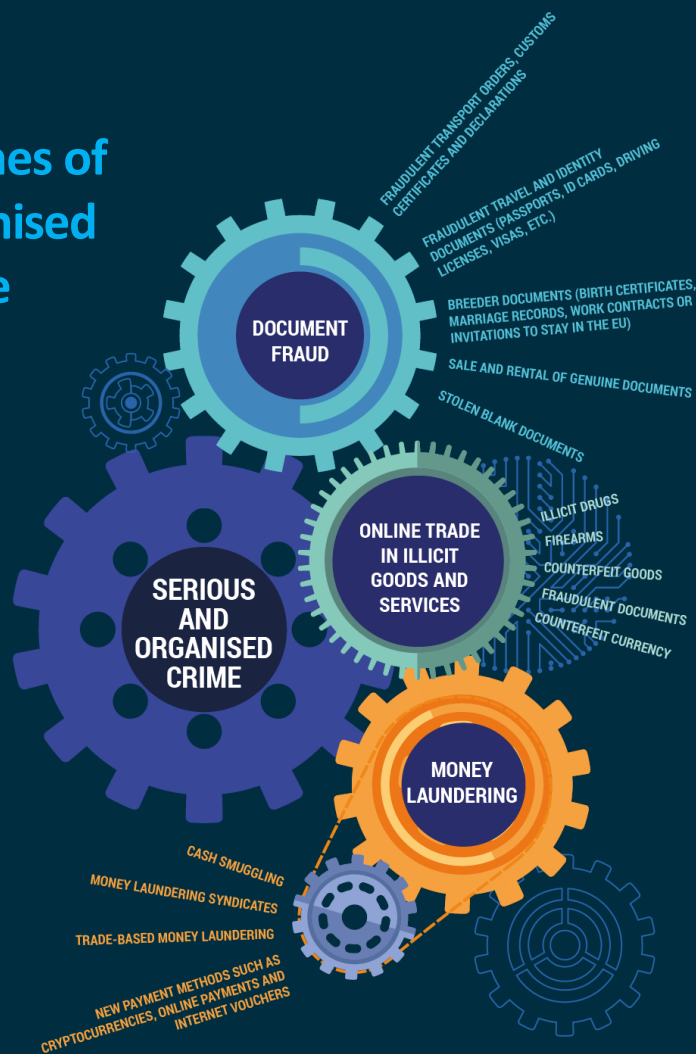
